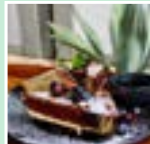

FOR THE ADULTS

Take a break from the kids for some after-hours fun. Every Thursday night, the **Exploratorium** and the **California Academy of Sciences** transform into adults-only playgrounds with live music, cocktails, and intellectually stimulating exhibits for everyone ages 21 and over.

Kick off your vacation with a splash at the Bay Area's newest waterpark, **Six Flags Hurricane Harbor**, or go for a high-flying ride at **Six Flags Discovery Kingdom** in nearby Vallejo. (The faint of heart can opt instead for the amusement park's animal attractions.)

Fall down the rabbit hole at **Children's Fairyland** in Oakland. On the shores of Lake Merritt, the enchanting theme park delights with fantastical storybook settings. Or spend a day with the Peanuts at the **Charles M. Schulz Museum** in Santa Rosa.

Who says learning can't be exciting? Dance with your shadow, touch a tornado, and stop time at San Francisco's **Exploratorium**, where



kids can interact with hundreds of mind-bending exhibits. Or experience natural history like never before at the **California Academy of Sciences** in **Golden Gate Park**. This thrilling, state-of-the-art museum includes a planetarium, a massive butterfly habitat, a living garden on the roof, and an aquarium. (Make sure to say hi to Claude, the albino alligator!) For some winter magic, lace on ice skates all year round at **Oakland Ice Center**.

If you'd like to stay in shape while you're here, visit the **YMCA of Pleasant Hill**. There you'll find fitness classes, a swimming pool, pilates, and Crossfit while your kids are safely occupied with fun activities at the in-house child minding facility.

Unleash the fun at **Round 1 Bowling and Amusement**. Play a round bowling, have fun at the arcade, or climb to the top of the rock wall and enjoy the trampolines at **Rockin Jump**.



ZOOTOPIA

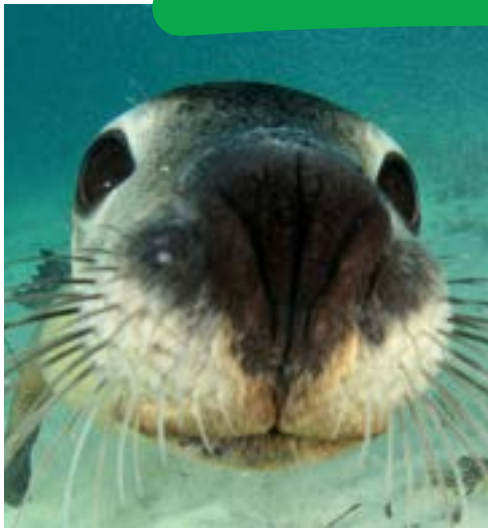

Go for a ride on the wild side at **Safari West**, a unique 400-acre wildlife reserve in Sonoma that brings the Serengeti experience to the **Wine Country**. Take a guided tour or book a private safari to catch glimpses of more than 90 African species such as cheetahs, gazelles, zebras, hyenas, rhinos, and more.

If you want to avoid the hustle and bustle of city life, take a trip up to **First Street** in **Downtown Napa**. Boasting nearly 40 boutiques, stores, restaurants, and tasting rooms, a stroll down First Street is sure to appeal to visitors looking for a more laid-back shopping experience.

Or shop **The Veranda**. A newly reimaged mixed-use retail center with open-air shopping and dining, gourmet grocer, Whole Foods, a luxury movie theatre, and other contemporary experiences. Beautiful architecture, lush landscaping, water features, and outstanding amenities will make it the ultimate gathering place where people can relax, shop, dine or attend a variety of special events.

SHORELINE SPECTACLE

Few beaches have as iconic a backdrop as San Francisco's **Baker Beach**. Sitting under the shadow of the Golden Gate Bridge, it's a great spot to snap that perfect family shot for the 'gram.



Soak in that famous California sunshine and splash in the water at the Bay Area's beaches. With a stunning coastline, amazing surfing, a world-class boardwalk, and a true hang-loose attitude, there's a reason why **Santa Cruz** is considered the quintessential beach town. **Santa Cruz Main Beach** has something for everyone. Shred some waves, go kayaking, or take a dip in the ocean; play a game of volleyball or catch some rays on the wide-open beach; or take a thrill ride over the boardwalk on a rollercoaster. **Ocean Beach** in San Francisco is ideal for a family stroll and offers easy access to **Golden Gate Park** and the picturesque ruins of the **Sutro Baths**. (Note: Due to cold waters and strong currents, swimming is not recommended at this beach.)



Nestled along the **Tiburon shore** in the North Bay, **Paradise Beach** will make you feel like you're in ... well, paradise. Quiet and remote, the tranquil beach and gentle surf creates the perfect spot to get away for a swim in the cool waters or a ride aboard a kayak or paddleboard.

Enjoy America's pastime with nine innings of the Bay Area's two legendary baseball teams, the **San Francisco Giants** and **Oakland A's**. Led by all-time greats Steph Curry and Klay Thompson, the **Golden State Warriors** know how to put on a show on the basketball court. Grab a seat at the **Chase Center** and watch as the Splash Brothers dominate the opposition. Are you ready for some football?

Calling the Bay Area home since 1946, the **San Francisco 49ers** are one of the region's most storied franchises. Head down to **Levi's Stadium** in **Santa Clara** as the **49ers** compete for gridiron glory. (Tip: **Make sure to check out the stadium's awesome team museum.**)

San Jose counts two pro teams—the **Sharks**, which is the Bay Area's hockey team, and the **Earthquakes** the Major League Soccer team. Join the teams' dedicated fan bases and cheer as the players battle for victory.

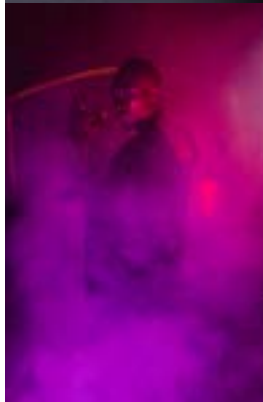

TRAILS & TREKS

EASY:

Frequented by locals and visitors alike, **Briones Regional Park** is a lovely stretch of rolling grassy hills and shaded oak canopies ideal for a leisurely stroll or pedal. **The Alhambra Creek Staging Area** in Martinez is a popular trailhead among families as well as outdoor enthusiasts.

MODERATE:

With more than 39 miles of trails winding through 2,079 acres of forested hills, **Tilden Regional Park** in Berkeley offers hikers and bikers plenty of room to get moving.

For stunning Bay Area views, traverse the 4.3-mile **Seaview and Big Springs trails loop**. Just be ready to work up a sweat—the loop has an elevation gain of 984 feet.

ADVANCED:

For some serious heart-pumping action, take on **Mount Diablo State Park**, the largest peak in the area. Start at the South Gate Road entrance, then bike up 11.2 miles with an elevation gain of 3,249 feet.

EASY:

Tucked into the oak-lined Livermore Valley, the five-mile-long [Lake Del Valle](#) in [Del Valle Regional Park](#) is best known for its fishing and boating opportunities. The lake is well stocked with trout and catfish, though dedicated anglers have been known to reel in largemouth, smallmouth, and striped bass as well as panfish. You can fish from the shore or launch any size vessel at the public boat launch (fees vary depending on watercraft size). Left your oars at home? Rent a motor - boat, patio boat, pedal boat, or canoe at the [East Beach](#) marina area.

MODERATE: For an exhilarating experience that's fun for the whole family, head to the open sea in an ocean kayak. Launch from several spots

With pristine waters and access to the Pacific Ocean, the Bay Area offers a unique opportunity to experience life on the sea. See wildlife up close on an epic adventure with the Oceanic Society. The 7.5-hour trip to the Farallon Islands, a marine sanctuary about 30 miles west of San Francisco where you can catch sight of whales, dolphins, seals, and other creatures.



along Sausalito's shoreline, or sign up for a tour led by a local outfitter, some of which feature stops at the [Golden Gate Bridge](#) or [Angel Island](#). Or stay close to home with a guided paddle at the [Martinez Marina](#), where you can leisurely explore the tranquil [Carquinez Strait](#).

ADVANCED: Looking to venture out onto the water? Spend your morning or afternoon paddling around the [San Francisco Bay](#) on a stand-up paddleboard (SUP). Many outfitters in [Alameda](#) and [Benicia](#) rent out boards and will teach you how to gently pull yourself along the shore or ride some mini-swells for a toning arm and core workout. Pit yourself against the elements on a guided river expedition with [All-Outdoors California White-water Rafting](#).



Pack in as much sightseeing as you can, while riding the waves on a ferry cruise around the bay. Catch any of the ferries departing for San Francisco, take a guided tour to historic Alcatraz Island, or embark on a pleasant day-trip cruise to Angel Island.

ICE ICE, BABY

FOR SOME TRULY EPIC SNOW PLAY, HEAD TO THE MOUNTAINS FOR A WIDE RANGE OF WINTER FUN.

EASY: About a three-hour drive due east of Pleasant Hill is the spectacular **Yosemite National Park**. Although beautiful in any season, a snowblanketed Yosemite is simply magical, especially when explored by snowshoe. Any of the trails in the **Crane Flat** area are great for snowshoeing.

MODERATE: About four hours away, **Tahoe** is definitely a winter wonderland, with more than 10 ski resorts in the area. Hit the slopes for some fast-paced skiing and snowboarding.

Or take in the tranquil alpine views on well-groomed trails via a pair of cross-country skis. Many Tahoe resorts offer day rentals as well as lessons for first-time skiers and snowboarders.

ADVANCED: For some backcountry adventuring, sign up for a guided tour on **Mammoth Mountain**. An expert instructor will lead you and a small group of skiers into new terrain, where you'll discover incredible sights while learning downhill ski skills in a one-of-a-kind mountain experience.

BONUS:

Shred a different kind of icy terrain in **Half Moon Bay**. Every winter, avid surfers make the pilgrimage to **Mavericks** to ride on massive swells that can top out at 60 feet.

(Note: Amateur surfers should get a little more experience before taking on these waves.)

Just relax

You don't have to go far for chilly fun. If you're here from November through January, bundle up for outdoor ice-skating at Walnut Creek on Ice!





Rest at the Summit Visitor Center, where visitors can get a 360-degree view of the Bay Area and beyond, with vistas of the Golden Gate Bridge and Farallon Islands to the west, Mount Hamilton to the southeast, the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta to the east, and Lassen Peak in the Cascades to the north.

Then enjoy a well-earned downhill cruise on your way back down the mountain. If you don't feel up to making the grueling trek but still want to witness the incredible mountain views, not to worry—you can drive up and park at the summit.

By Car

By Train

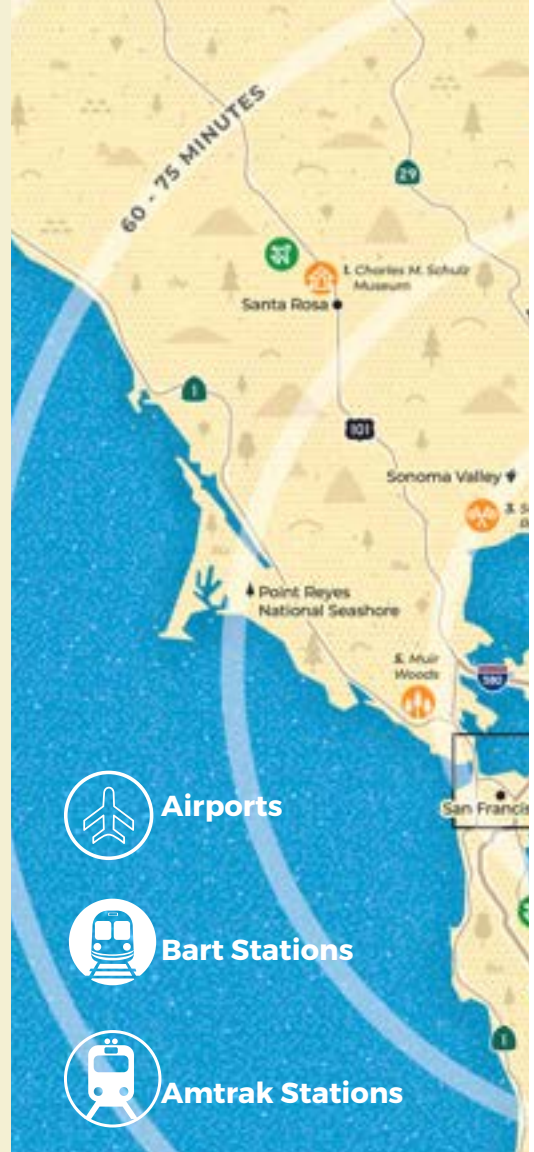
